

Iowa Plumbing and Mechanical Systems Board Continuing Education Requirements:

Confused regarding which courses you need to renew your license? Use the following chart below to make sure you have fulfilled the IPMSB requirements:

LICENSES HELD	SAFETY	MECHANICAL CODE	PLUMBING CODE	DISCIPLINE	TOTAL
Single License in Refrigeration, Hydronics, or HVAC	2 hrs	+ 2 hrs +	0 hrs +	4 hrs in licensed discipline	= 8 hrs
Single License in Plumbing	2 hrs	+ 0 hrs +	2 hrs +	4 hrs Plumbing	= 8 hrs
Multiple Licenses in Refrigeration, Hydronics, or HVAC	4 hrs	+ 2 hrs +	0 hrs +	8 hrs in any combination of licensed disciplines	= 14 hrs
Multiple Licenses in Plumbing, Refrigeration, Hydronics, or HVAC	4 hrs	+ 2 hrs +	2 hrs +	8 hrs in any combination of licensed disciplines	= 16 hrs

After *successful* completion of **SAVE: HVAC System Performance Training** you will receive (2) hrs of Mechanical Code and (8) hrs of HVAC discipline. Therefore, you will need the following additional hours outlined in the chart below to renew your license **assuming you hold a HVAC license**. (If you **DO NOT** have a HVAC license, only the (2) hrs of code will apply toward your license renewal).

Multiple Licenses in Refrigeration, Hydronics, or HVAC	4 hrs	+ 0 hrs +	0 hrs +	0 hrs	= 4 hrs
Multiple Licenses in Plumbing, Refrigeration, Hydronics, or HVAC	4 hrs	+ 0 hrs +	2 hrs +	0 hrs	= 6 hrs
